 - A "kid-powered entry" means a child (children) 6 to 17 years old is pulling or riding the entry.
 - Put a sign on your entry; the judges and audience must be able to see which category you're in.
- 4) Stop/perform in front of the Chamber of Commerce office. Allow the announcer to share your details before you move forward.
